### **Voucher Site Opportunities**

**10:00am-2:00pm at a Voucher Site on the first day of a Severe Weather Event**

#### **Voucher Site Assistant**

- Help coordinate Guest traffic flow
- Engage with Guests and determine possible needs
- Organize and distribute supplies as necessary
- Assist with Guest check in
- Preparing and serving snacks and drinks

### **Food Volunteer Opportunities**

**5:45pm-8:30pm (depending on role) at a Church Host Site on a Severe Weather Night**

**\*(Volunteers may certainly participate in any/all of the food roles on a single severe weather night)**

#### **Food Team Lead**

- Contact all Volunteers for the evening on a severe weather night prior to 9:30am
- Notify Food Donation and Preparation Volunteers about number of meals to provide
- Arrive at distribution site to allow Volunteers into the building and prepare Volunteer assignments
- Lay out supplies for evening and create a space for an assembly line
- Reference/Print Weekly Roster for each motel

#### **Food Donation**

- Prepare a meal (hot or cold) and deliver to church (coordinate timing with Food Point Person)
- Donate fresh items for dinner and breakfast (i.e. fruit, salad, etc.)
- Donate shelf stable items for breakfast

#### **Food Preparation & Packaging**

- Assist in setting up process/assembly line to package meals for delivery to Guests at motels
- May be responsible for heating food or combining ingredients in preparation for packaging

#### **Food Delivery**

- Food Delivery will be performed by groups of 2 Volunteers per motel/room
- Report back to Regional Coordinator any needs or concerns that should be addressed

## Guest Care Opportunities

### Care Team

- Deeper connection with specific guests based on need to invest towards Relationship and Restoration
- Delivery of specific items
- One on one conversations with Guests
- Help follow through on obtaining resources
- Direct partnership with Regional Coordinators to address guest needs
- Partner with Miracle Messages

### Safety and health bag assembly (as needed from partners/volunteers)

- Organize safety and health items
- Prepare a bag to be handed out to each guest upon arrival at the Registration Site
- Bags may include items such as masks, hand sanitizer, gloves, and a variety of hygiene items
